Subject: Fiscal Year 2022 (FY22) Year-End Subcontract Reporting Extension

Federal contractors are continuing to work through challenges in subcontracting data collection and validation brought on by the COVID19 pandemic. Different geographic locations are in different stages of working remotely, reopening, and reinvention. Thus, to lessen the burden upon contractors, SBA is providing a ten-day extension to the submission due date for contractor's FY22 year-end Individual Subcontract Reports (ISR) and Summary Subcontract Reports (SSRs) and to the agency's time period to accept or reject the reports.

For rejected reports, contractors must still submit a revised report within 30 days of the rejection notice per FAR § 52.219-9(l), and agencies must acknowledge or reject the revised report within 30 days of submittal.
